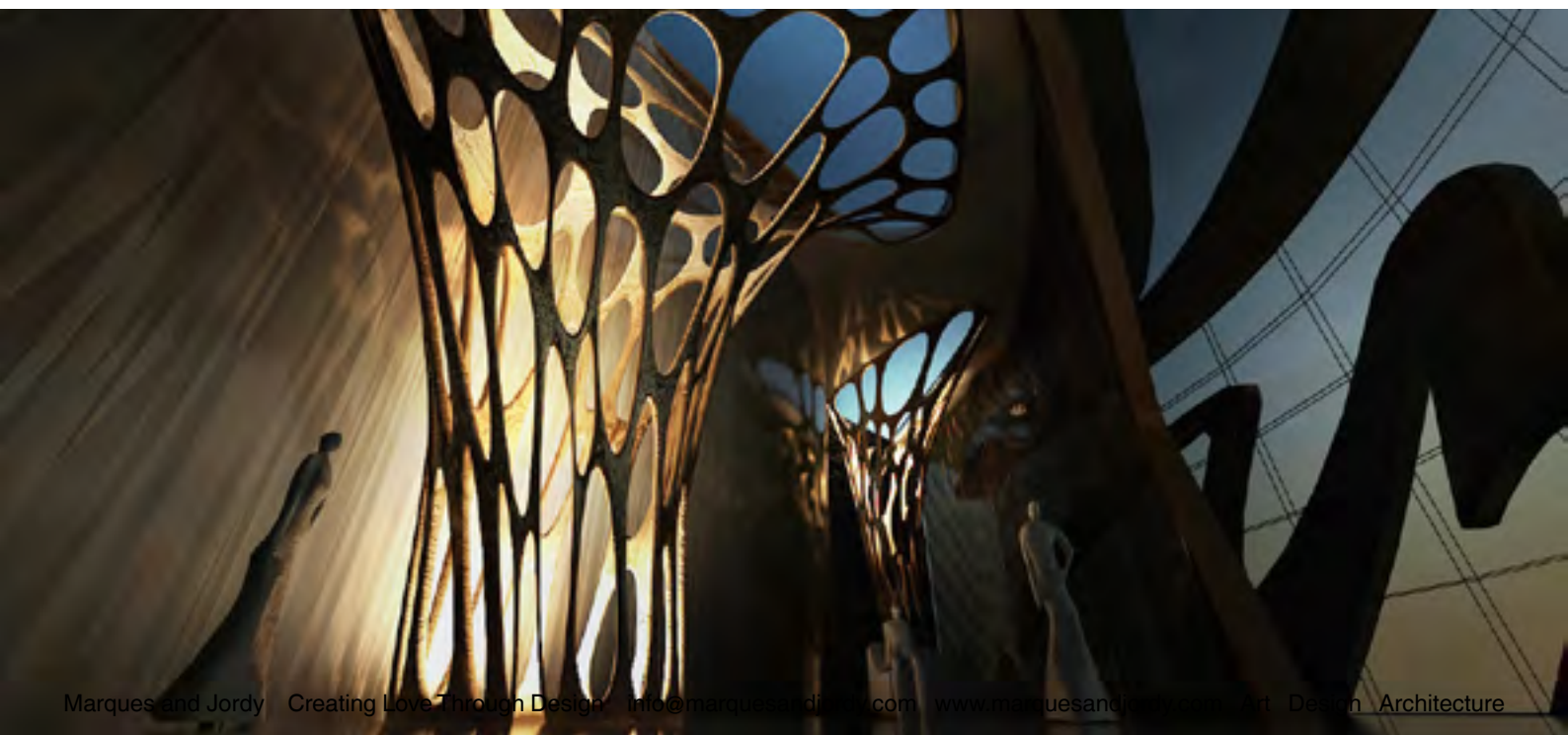


Marques and Jordy Push the Boundaries of Hospitality Design

Founded in London, Marques & Jordy is driven by a pursuit for creating love through design. We believe our surroundings and emotions directly influence the designs we work on.

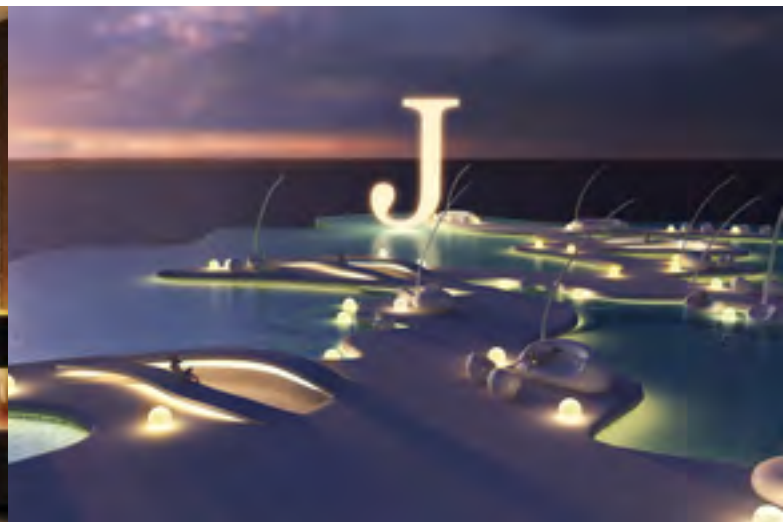
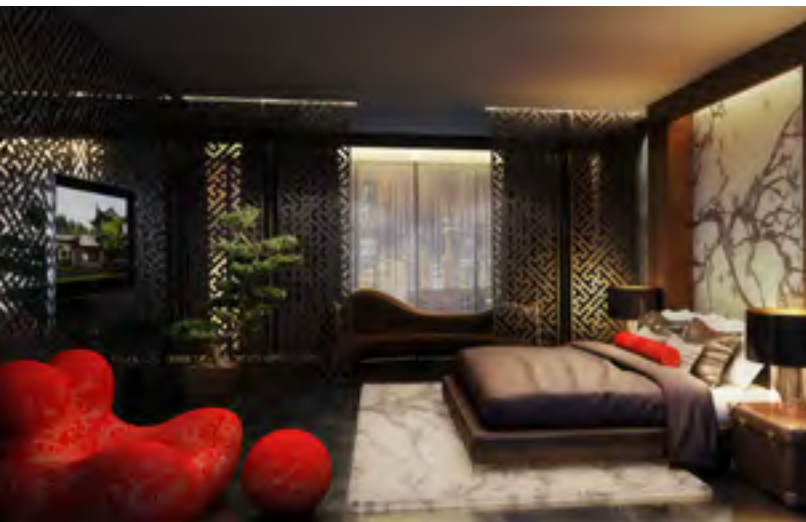
